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Our Storytelling Ethics

The San Diego Food System Alliance aspires to tell stories that are truthful, nuanced, educational, fair, and empowering. We believe that stories shape humanity.

Photography & Image-making

- We use all images and messages with the full understanding, participation, and permission of the constituent or the constituent's legal guardian.
- We explain to constituents the purpose of the story, where it will be used, and answer any questions they might have before photographing, filming, or recording.
- We research and respect the culture of the individual, group, community, or place we are documenting.
- We treat storytelling and image-making as a collaboration.
- We use discernment in candid photography and videography, because another's dignity and honor matters to us
- We inquire about how others are impacted by our images, examining the the actual results of our best intentions.
- · We are intentional about highlighting common humanity through images and storytelling.
- We refrain from making an image if asked not to.
- We foster the courage to delete some images that may reinforce destructive stereotypes, or publish them only along with other images that tell a more complete story.
- We uphold the dignity of our constituents through empowering imagery and messages that motivate engagement and inspire hope.

Storytelling & Interviewing

- We tell others' stories the way we want our own story told.
- We avoid questions, attitudes or comments that are judgmental or insensitive to cultural values, or that place an individual in danger, expose them to humiliation, or reactivate pain from traumatic events.
- We do not discriminate in choosing subjects to interview because of sex, race, age, religion, status, educational background or physical abilities.
- No staging: We do not ask subjects to tell a story or take an action that is not part of their own history.
- We strive to find an able translator if we speak a different language from our subject.
- We ask the constituent if they wish to be named or identified and act according to their wishes.
- We truthfully represent a situation or story to educate our audiences of the realities, complexities, and nuances of the issues we advocate for.
- We do not use images, footage, or words that sensationalize or stereotype a person or a situation.
- We ask for feedback from our subject and constituents, and incorporate this feedback into the final story.
- We abide by international law, standards, and protocols related to vulnerable persons.
- We choose not to tell the story, despite the resources invested, when the story cannot be told with the integrity of these ethics.
